100 SERIES: "A Crash Course for the Motorcyclist"

This is our most popular class. Learn what to do in the first 5-30 minutes after a crash until professional help arrives. Fully Instructor-Led (IL) by a certified ASM instructor, this 7-hour class (8 hours with lunch) teaches helmet removal, jaw thrust rescue breathing, moving the injured, controlling bleeding, and more. All skills are taught and & practiced.

300 SERIES: "Advanced Bystander Assistance"

Learn to be a leader at a scene as well as how to assist the EMS when they arrive. Advanced Airway Management, Common medical emergencies, assisting the EMS with Extrication, Femoral Traction, role play, and more are taught in this 7-hour instructor-led class (8 hours with a lunch break).

How it works:

Fill out the AMSAF Accident Scene Management scholarship application at www.amsaf.org/asm and pay the \$50 scholarship fee. After the fee is paid, you will receive 2 emails - I is the payment receipt, the second email from AMSAF is an email with your AMSAF ASM Scholarship Code (ASM -24- ####) Located in red at the bottom of your email.

Next- Register for your class at www.accidentscene.org When signing up, there are two comment fields: enter your email and the word AMSAF as the discount code. On the 2nd page, enter your demographic information and the AMSAF Scholarship code from your AMSAF confirmation. (this code will be on the bottom of 2nd AMSAF email in red - ASM -24- ####)

Upon the day of class, you MUST bring the AMSAF confirmation email with your unique student code AND the Accident Scene Management course registration confirmation to the ASM-approved instructor when you show up to attend your class.
