- developing unique partnerships with Arizona businesses to help reduce crashes and fatalities, such as Phillips Law Group
- increase participation in Scholarships through discount incentives
- Identify key industry liaisons that can help further the message and promote AMSAF's efforts through activities, events, and outreach opportunities
